# VEHICLE RULES

1. Vehicle registration is on a first come first serve basis. Space is limited to 12' wide by 20' long. Spaces will be numbered and assigned to the vehicle as registrations are accepted.
2. Vehicle registration deadline is prior to Friday 5:00 PM on October 27, 2017.
3. Check in time is between 4:00 and 5:00PM. Decoration must be completed prior to 5:00 PM for the kids  
Judging will begin at 5:00PM.
4. The size of your design/layout is needed. Here are examples of more than one car space used.



5. Your vehicle must stay for the entire 3 hour party. Have enough candy for all children to have at least 2-3 pieces.
6. Family appropriate themes. Avoid themes that stress the devil, witches, death, blood, fear, etc. We want this to be a safe, fun environment for children of all ages.
7. Sealed/wrapped candies only. (Examples - Hershey bars, Milky Way, Jolly Rancher, **NO Homemade treats**, etc.) You may handout items other than candy. ( i.e. pencils, small games, school supplies, crafts, etc.)
8. If you are in need of electric, you will need to supply your own car inverter or generator. Electricity from the bldg will not be supplied.
9. Vehicle judging will be done by visitors. Prizes for – 3 categories  
“Most original”                      “Scariest”                      “Funniest”.
10. Please ensure the area around your treat stop is clean and all trash removed prior to leaving.
